              Accurate Locating Services disagreed with the

board's conclusion and requested this hearing on

January 15. Accurate Locating Services is present today and is represented by attorney Lora Waeckerle. Cable Communications is present today and is represented by attorney Jess Pekarski. The board today is represented by attorney Cody Honeywell.

I am Catherine Williamson. I'm with the Office of Hearing Examiners. I will be conducting this hearing. The decision in this matter will be made by the One Call Board. Written findings and conclusions of law will be prepared after the hearing.

For the record, this matter was continued from the original March date, and Accurate has just retained counsel. And they probably have a motion here today.

I will go through the issues for today. It's whether the Cable Communications failed to maintain markings from a locate completed by Accurate Locating and to be aware of underground facilities along those markings; and, if Cable Communications had such a failure, whether penalties shall be imposed by the board pursuant to state rule or state law; and, if so, what will those penalties be.

All parties were noticed for this hearing, and the requirement for any exhibits to be shared was noticed in advance. The burden of proof is on Petitioner in this matter.

And I will ask the attorneys if they have any motions at this point in time.

MS. WAECKERLE: Yes, your Honor. Would that be appropriate?

ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE: That would be appropriate. That is fine.

MS. WAECKERLE: Okay. Do you mind if I sit down?

ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE: I do not mind.

MS. WAECKERLE: Okay. Thank you.

Thank you very much. My name is Lora Waeckerle.

I represent Accurate Locating Services and Dana Fetch.

I appreciate what an imposition it was to gather today. I can tell you that I've represented Accurate Locating Services for a little over 72 hours. I was out of state when I agreed to assist her. And my reasoning was she had communicated to me that she would not be able to present evidence in support of her complaint without an attorney because she operates with an LLC. And when I saw the access to justice issue I couldn't help but jump in, even though I knew there was a possibility we'd have an evidentiary hearing today 72 hours after agreeing to represent her.

I don't have a fee agreement with her even yet. That's how early our attorney-client relationship

is.

Ms. Fetch, when she sat down with me, indicated that she had had some struggles getting an attorney to represent her. That's very consistent with my understanding of the Rapid City market. Right now it's hard to find lawyers. And given the fact that she was in a frustrating position, I was hopeful that I could continue it and hopefully give her a little more due process than a 72-hour prep session. It was rough. And I appreciate that it's frustrating for everyone, not just me.

But I did do everything in my power to get prepared today. That included basically not sleeping last night to get exhibits ready. Accurate Locating Services does object to the proceeding on the grounds that I view that my client's due process rights will be violated because she was unable to act.

So it wasn't a situation where she was neglectful. It was more a situation where she couldn't find somebody who had the authority to put on evidence on her behalf.

So, obviously, I would refer and defer to my motion to continue, which I filed yesterday. But this is a quasi-judicial proceeding, and so due process would apply to it. And so although we do object and we stand

on that objection, I do have an exhibit list and witness lists that I can serve and I do have exhibits prepared and ready to give the board if it elects to overrule my objection and have an evidentiary proceeding today.

I will represent that it's not my practice to give exhibit lists and witness lists on the date of hearings, but I will also represent that it was not physically possible for me to get the exhibit list put together until early this morning.

So that's the basis of my motion. And combined with my affidavit and the motion, the written motion that I filed yesterday.

ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE: Thank you.

I did receive the motion to continue and the affidavit of Ms. Waeckerle, and they are placed in the record.

Mr. Pekarski, do you have any objection to this motion or comment?

MR. PEKARSKI: As far as an objection to the motion for continuance, yesterday we stated in our response to counsel we have no objection to the continuance at that time. However, we wanted to take into account our witnesses' time, having to appear today, and a consideration for how we're going to schedule, if

we're going to schedule it moving forward.

Second, we'd also like it noted for the record that this is the second continuance. So 60 days has expired, meaning there was time the first time to look for counsel as well. There was time and a deadline to submit exhibits and information and evidence to support her case.

Those times have expired before she ever requested a continuance. I would like that noted for the record. We'd make an objection to supplemented evidence or anything else at this point in time because that expired prior to any request for a continuance. We believe the record should stand with what she presented.

We'd make an alternative motion that the case be dismissed for failure to present any evidence at this point in time.

ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE: Okay. Thank you.

Anything in rebuttal? I'll give one more shot.

MS. WAECKERLE: Okay. Thank you.

I would again urge the board not to restrict my client's ability to present evidence, as I do believe given the fact that she was unable to submit anything on April 8 due to the lack of a law license that she was restrained in a way that I believe it would violate the constitution and the due process clause to restrict her

ability to put forth evidence because this is a quasi-judicial proceeding.

And in the event that our exhibits are not accepted by the board as affirmative evidence, I would ask the opportunity to proffer any evidence I have with me today for the purposes of an appeal to the Circuit Court.

ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE: Anything?

MR. PEKARSKI: Nothing further, your Honor.

ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE: Okay. Thank you very

much.

Because the board is here today, I'm going to leave this up to the board to determine whether this matter will be continued or not. And, with that, I'd ask that they go into executive session to make such a determination.

So if we could clear the room and put the two members that are on Zoom into a separate room and have that room broadcast in here. And we'll be off the record at this time.
