- South Dakota One Call was established in 1993, under SDCL 49-7A and Admin Rules section 20:25.
- The Board of Directors, appointed by the Governor's Office, are tasked with protecting utilities, preventing damages and promoting public safety.
- Our One Call Center, Texas811 is based is Dallas. TX.
   We have contracted with Texas811 for fourteen years as the one call center provider for South Dakota 811.
- Excavators do not pay for locates. Utilities fully fund this service.
- Protecting underground utilities, people, equipment and communities takes everyone meeting the 811 laws!

### Digging in to Portal

#### **EXCAVATOR BENEFITS**

Excavators and homeowners are able to enter locate tickets without calling 811. By creating a Portal account, you as the excavator can submit all required information to set up a locate, including mapping the work zone.

- ✓ Portal Accounts are free to all uses
- ✓ View previously submitted tickets.
- ✓ View Positive Response from utilities on the status of your locate.
- Take additional action on a locate ticket as needed, such as request a Verification, update the ticket or request a respot.

#### **UTILITY BENEFITS:**

As a utility, Portal is a great way to view mapping for a locate and to enter Positive Response.

- ✓ Free access!
- Web based, response can be entered in the field or the office.
- View mapping provided by the excacator.

## Admin Rule Changes

Updates for both utilities and excavators

South Dakota 811 Board of Directors made two changes to administrative rules this fall, 1. limiting an update ticket and 2. Mandatory Positive Response. These two changes will in effect on January 1, 2025.

Update Tickets (Admin Rule 20:25:30:05:01)

- South Dakota 811 became aware of a potential issue causing delays to locates. When a ticket is updated for a jobsite that is not under construction, it draws locators and utilities away from locating for active excavation.
- By limiting updates, we believe this will cause the excavator to pause and review the work description, verifying that locating is happening where work is occurring.
- This change allows for the original ticket plus two updates from the original ticket, before a new ticket has to be entered.

Positive Response (Admin Rule 20:25:01:01)

- This communication tool allows the excavator to check the status of the locate prior to arriving at the jobsite.
- Positive Response can be found in Portal by entering the ticket number in the search bar. Under the VIEW tab, go to Positive Response.
- NO, this change does not allow the excavator to dig prior to the start date and start time on the locate ticket. This changes does not effect the 48 hour response time provided to utilities.
