HECLA CITY COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

Special session of the Hecla City Council met October 9th, 2023 11:00 a.m. at the Hecla City Office. Present were members Freudenthal, Ravert, Ruenz, Treeby, Ulmer and Vancil. Mayor Pfutzenreuter presided. Brandon Casey, Jessica Casey, Bob Lloyd, Daryl Lloyd, and Tyler Thayer also present.

Purpose of the meeting was for discussion on a variance for installation of residential septic tank.

Motion by Freudenthal, seconded by Ravert to approve the agenda with the following additions: Discussion on SDML Conference overview from Mayor, and Policy and Procedure discussion. All present voted aye. Motion carried.

Mayor Pfutzenreuter gave a brief overview of the SDML Annual Municipal Conference and recommended Council attempt to go in the future as it is a great way to learn municipal information and to network with other municipal officials.

Mayor Pfutzenreuter discussed the need for policy and procedure to be updated so that everyone is aware how things should be handled instead of miscommunication and that the Council review current policies and procedures for the future.

Public Comment: No public in attendance gave comment at meeting.

Variance on Septic Tank: After discussion with Tyler Thayer, motion was made by Ruenz, seconded by Ulmer to approve a variance from current ordinance for Tyler Thayer to resume installation of a septic tank on his personal property and to disconnect from City wastewater facilities. All voted aye. Motion carried.

There being no further business from the Council, Mayor Pfutzenreuter declared the meeting adjourned at 11:41 a.m.
